August 26, 2020 will mark the 100th Anniversary of the ratification of the 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution, granting millions of women the right to vote. As the group Indivisible Suffragists explains, ninety-seven years after gaining the right to vote, women of every heritage may be able to vote but are now faced with the most openly sexist, regressive, bigoted, corrupt and dangerous administration in United States history. As Heather Heyer stated on Facebook before she was martyred by a white supremacist in Charlottesville, Virginia, "If you're not outraged, you're not paying attention." On August 26th 2017 thousands of people heard Congresswoman Judy Chu speak in solidarity of



the 1st Annual INDIVISIBLE MARCH on Women's Equality Day. In dedication to the memory of Heather and all victims of oppression, many rallied in front of City Hall in downtown Los Angeles, California. Sister INDIVISIBLE Marches and Rallies organized across the United States also took place in Alaska, District of Columbia, Georgia, Hawaii, Indiana, Minnesota, Nevada, Pennsylvania, Utah, Washington and West Virginia. We hope many more will join in organizing for 2018.
